


CENTRAL PARK



Designed by Frederick Law Olmsted and Calvert Vaux, Central Park influenced the development of urban parks nationwide and is widely regarded as a masterpiece of landscape architecture. **It has eight lakes and ponds that were created artificially** by damming natural seeps and flows. Central Park is full of attractions, from green meadows to sprawling waters, **gardens and unique bridges,** music and performance centers, educational facilities, classical architecture and more. Its picturesque beauty boasts natural green landscapes and vistas as far as the eye can see.
